Wildlife Killed or Seen by Pike Between St. Anthony and Little Falls, September 28 to 1805

Sept 28, Killed a goose and Raccoon

29th, killed large raccoon

30th, no report

1st of October, Killed one goose and two ducks

2nd, Killed three geese and two swans, great sign of deer and elk

3rd, Killed three geese and one raccoon and a brilau blaireau

4th, at mouth of Crow River in morning, then at mouth of Elk River, pursued a flock of elk all day, first sight of pocket gopher. Killed two geese, one pheasant and a wolf. 5th, Killed one goose.

6th, Chased four elk that swam the river, wounded one but did not find it. Saw great signs of elk and two more droves of elk. Killed some small game including three prairie hens

of elk and two more droves of elk. Killed some small game including three pra and two pheasants.

7th, Killed three prairie hens and six pheasants.

8th, killed one raccoon

9th, 10th, 11th, 12th, 13th, no record.

14th, Killed three deer, four geese and two porcupines, startled a large bear, feeding on a large deer carcass.

15th, killed two deer, five ducks, two geese.

16th Saw five deer, killed one buck.

17th, Killed four bear and three deer.

18th, Stopped hunting to build winter quarters.

22nd, resumed hunting, Saw great quantity of deer.

23rd, Killed a number of pheasants and ducks.

24th, Killed four deer, two geese and two pheasants.

25th, killed nothing.

26th, Killed three deer.

27th, No hunting.

Totals, Killed 19 geese, 6 prairie hens, two swans, one wolf, 13 pheasants, two porcupines, 16 deer, 9 ducks, four bears, four raccoons, pursued and hunted elk twice.
